



How to configure supported television picture settings

Depending on your television picture settings, the VidyoConnect Room or VidyoRoom UI may not be properly aligned. This could cause the edges of the UI to appear cut off as shown here:



If you notice this with your television, refer to this table to reconfigure your television picture settings to properly align the user interface:

<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Press Menu on your TV remote.2. Select <i>Picture > Picture Options</i>.3. Select Just Scan.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Press P. Size on your TV remote.2. Select Screen Fit.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Press Menu on your TV remote.2. Select <i>Picture > Advanced Settings</i>.3. Turn Overscan Off.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Press Wide on your TV remote.2. Select <i>Wide Mode > Full</i>.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Press Display on your TV remote.2. Select Normal.
